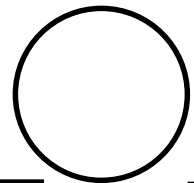
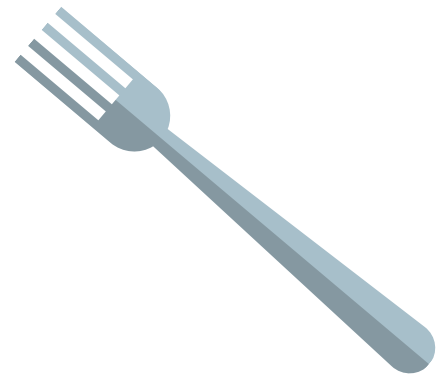
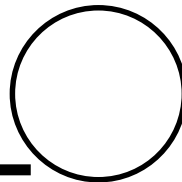
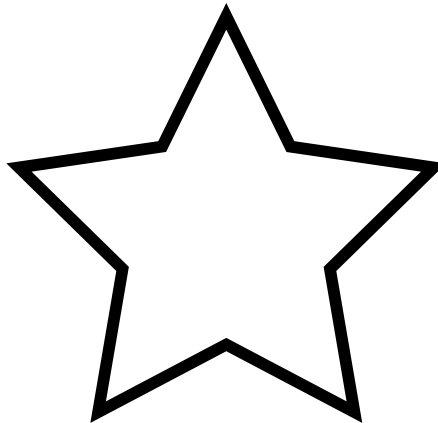
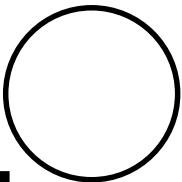
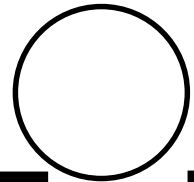
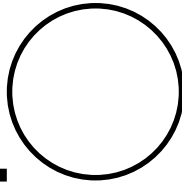
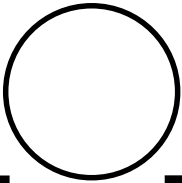


R-CONTROLLED VOWELS

The pictures are words that have either an "ar" or an "or" vowel sound. These are called "r-controlled vowels" or "bossy r vowels". The "r" makes the vowel change it's sound. "OR" makes a sound like in the word "storm". "AR" makes a sound like in the word "car". Say the name of each picture and try to decide if the r-controlled vowel is an "or" or and "ar".



R-controlled vowels make one sound together so they need to be grouped together and read together as one sound. Write the correct r-controlled vowel sound in each circle, then tap out the word to find the remaining sounds and write the letters to complete each word.
